

SUPPLY LIST for High School Visual Art Students

- Portfolio- close to 24 x 30 is the recommended size. This can be a paper or plastic portfolio.
- Storage bin—this can be anything simple to keep art supplies for class organized. An ArtBin, tackle box or plastic “shoe bin” works well. Remember: **Cannot be more than 14” long**
- Sketchbook (8.5 x 11”)—recommend spiral bound sketchbooks
- Bristol paper pad (9” x 12” or 11” x 14”)—these come in multiple brands / any brand or variety works
- Drawing pencils HB, B, H, 2H, 4H
- Vinyl erasers / small manual pencil sharpener
- Colored pencils (Prisma brand is the recommendation)
- 2 Micron 02 and 005 and 2 sharpies (fine point)
- X-acto knife # 11 with extra blades
- 2 sets (one for acrylic and one for oil) of long handled synthetic paint brushes in a range of styles- flats, brights, round
- Painting knife (diamond shape, suggested size #1 Liquitex)
