## Spanish 1 Supplies & Summer Assignments

### Required Supplies for Spanish 1-4:

**your SCPA planner** This is your hall pass.  
**a 1.5 inch 3 ring binder**  
**a composition notebook or similar sized notebook**  
**5 divider tabs** (if you already have 8, that's fine)  
**a folder** (optional—to be used to take work home if you would like to leave your binder in my room and not carry home)  
**pens** Please have at least two different colors.  
**pencils and eraser**  
**plenty of loose-leaf paper**

### Optional Community Supplies:

Thank you for anything you are able to contribute.  
**Tissues!!!**  
**hand sanitizer**  
**general cleaning supplies (Swiffer cloths, paper towels, Clorox wipes, etc.)**  
**dry erase markers**

### Summer Work for students entering Spanish 1:

1. Your first assignment is to sign up for REMIND. This will allow you to receive communication regarding opportunities to review/preview and earn first quarter credit throughout the summer. Text **@mi1profe4** to the number 81010. Once you have done this you will also have the ability to ask me questions, if you have them, through Remind. Also, there is a Remind app that most students find helpful that you can download if you want.
2. Create an account on Duolingo and join my class. (Do NOT login with Google or FB.) Test it out. (Duolingo.com)
  - Go to *settings*, then *progress sharing*. If on a computer, click the blue “Don’t have a classroom code?”
  - Enter my email: [sunderwood@scpa.org](mailto:sunderwood@scpa.org) and then pick: Spanish 1 bell 7 (even if that isn’t your bell).
  - Write down your login information so you will remember it.
  - Test it out by practicing and unlocking skills. Whatever you do over summer will earn you points for first Qtr.
3. Create an account on Quizlet and join my class. Practice any quizlet set you want. (Quizlet.com)
  - Do not login with Google or Facebook. **Write down your login information so you will remember it.**
  - After you have created an account, and click “join or create a class” on the left. As you start typing under *create a class* it will give suggestions at the bottom of classes that already exist. If you type “scpa Cincinnati” it will find it. When you find the right one, click “request to join”. My classes are called “español 1” “español 2” and “español 3 y 4”. (Make sure you aren’t signing up for Spanish at SCPA in San Diego!)
