During remote learning, SCPA students will have a **Flex-Day**. Flex-Day for students in grades 4-12 will occur on Monday, and Friday for K-3 students.

This unique schedule during remote learning will be used to address the social emotional learning for students. It will allow opportunities for teachers to hold small/large group student grade level or department meetings, master classes, club meetings, leader in me lessons and other presentations (i.e. connecting with outside learning institutions, virtual college visitation days, virtual field trips etc.).

It's also an opportunity for our support staff such as our school counselors, school psychologists, school speech pathologists, and school administrators to make personal one-on-one connections with students and families.

Student participation is **mandatory**. Teachers will connect with students regarding their participation in activities through Schoology.
