

AP biology update April 3, 2020.

After an extended wait, I have found the following information regarding the AP biology test. Please read carefully as some of this has changed since our last communication a couple of days ago.

- 1. The test will still involve the units one through six give it to you in my last communication.**
- 2. The nature of the test will be a 45 minute duration online. You will answer the first question free response and we given 20 minutes to write it and then five minutes to download. The second free response question you'll be given 15 minutes to write it in five minutes to download it.**
- 3. There will be two testing episodes. One will be on May 18 at 2 o'clock Eastern standard time. The second exam will be given on June 3 at 4 PM Eastern standard time. As we get closer to test dates they said they would give you more information about what you needed to have. They could not tell me any more than this !**
- 4. The support of videos on YouTube message earlier have changed. There will not be six of them there instead will be eight and they have come out much quicker than what they said. All you need to do is go onto YouTube, search "advanced placement" , go to your discipline and subject and the videos will be there. Part of your notebook grade will be watching those and taking very astute notes. This is not something that I would wait to try to do it in the last week. The videos have been aired on March 25, 26th, 27th, 30th 31st and on April 1st, 2nd and 3rd.**
