1. Here is your next script – **Boy**. **Please read this script**. Remembering that this is based on a true story, make notes for discussion. Pay attention to how gender was identified at the time of this story. What decisions were made and why? Did the doctor prove his theory? Is gender defined differently today? Be ready to discuss when we return in April.

## 2. SENIOR PROJECTS –

Please use some of this new found time to work on your senior project. Some of you may even be able to get it completed. You can have rehearsals since none of your scripts are more than 100 cast members. When we return, senior projects will be three weeks away.

Remember to write in your journals. I would expect to see some reflection of this time of being out of school.
