- pens** Please have at least two different colors.
- pencils and eraser**
- plenty of loose-leaf paper**

Summer Work for students entering Spanish 1:

1. Your first assignment is to sign up for Remind. This will allow you to receive communication regarding opportunities to review/preview and earn first quarter credit throughout the summer. Text **@entersp1** to the number 81010. Once you have done this you will also have the ability to ask me questions, if you have them, through Remind. Also, there is a Remind app that most students find helpful that you can download if you want. Please note that some form of successful communication with me is required, so if Remind doesn't work for you or you don't want to use it, you need to email me to work out an alternative.
2. Create an account on Duolingo (duolingo.com) and join my class. (Logging in with Google or FB does NOT create an account.) Test it out. To join my class, use this class code: **P Q Q U M V** (Make sure it's a class and not a club). OR
 - If on a computer, click the blue "Don't have a classroom code?"
 - Enter my email: sunderwood@scpa.org and then pick: Spanish 1.
 - Write down your login information so you will remember it. (There is an app, but write it down anyway.)
 - Test it out by practicing and unlocking skills. If you have no previous experience with Spanish, I recommend starting with *Introduction, Common Phrases, and/or Greetings*. If you'd like 1st quarter credit for what you do over the summer send me a message first, and I will create 'assignments' for the topics you are interested in.
3. Create an account on Quizlet (quizlet.com) and join my class. Practice any quizlet set you want.
 - Please create a username that includes your actual name. After you have created an account, click "join or create a class" on the left. As you start typing under *create a class* it will give suggestions at the bottom of classes that already exist. If you type "scpa Cincinnati" it will find it. When you find the right one, click "request to join". My classes are called "español 1" "español 2" and "español 3 y 4". (Make sure you aren't signing up for Spanish at SCPA in San Diego!)
 - Do not login with Google or Facebook. That does not create an account. Write down your login information so you will remember it. If you have an account on day 1 and can remember how to log into it, you will receive credit for a 1st quarter assignment.
