Good Day SCPA Families! We are preparing to receive students back in the building for 5 Days of In Person learning, Wednesday, March 31st. I am sending a Google Survey both online and a paper version to obtain feedback on what option our families will choose for their student(s). Group B In-Person students received the paper copy today. Group A will receive the paper copy Tuesday, March 16th. **Parents only need to complete either the paper or electronic form. Your paper copy or electronic submission must be completed by Friday, March 19th. Once you have decided on your choice, there will be no changes allowed during 4th Quarter.**
