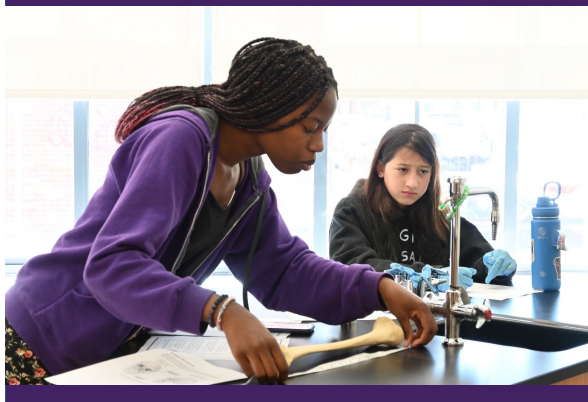

What is College Credit Plus? (CCP)



 **College Credit Plus is Ohio's dual credit program**

 Students can earn high school and college credit at the same time

 Students enroll in college courses and adhere to the policies and requirements of the college

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Who is eligible for CCP?



Students must be Ohio Residents in 7th-12th grade

Anticipated eligibility for 2022-2023:

- Cumulative 3.0 GPA
- Qualifying Accuplacer Test Score
 - Must pass 1 of the 3 sections: Math, Reading, Writing

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Paying for CCP Classes



Public school: The State of Ohio will pay for public school students to take up to 30 credit hours per academic year.

Private/ Homeschool: Students families will apply for funding from the state of Ohio between February and April 1 of each year to be awarded credit hours.

Limitations:

The State of Ohio will not pay for college level:

- Health/ Gym
- 1 on 1 instruction (such as 1 on 1 piano lessons)

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How do I take classes?



Students can take classes for the Summer, Fall, and Spring.

Upcoming Start dates:

- June 6, 2022
- August 22, 2022
- January 17, 2023

Courses can be taken in person at Chatfield or online.

- Leave their high school early or go late to take classes in person on Chatfield's Campus.
- Take a study hall at your high school to do your classes online through Canvas.

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When do I take classes?



In person classes are offered once a week to allow for the most flexibility for our students.

Attend during our block schedule:

- 9 am – 12:00 pm
- 12:30 pm – 3:15 pm
- 4:00 pm – 6:30 pm
- 6:30 pm – 9:15 pm



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Transfer Credit



Chatfield College is Accredited through the Higher Learning Commission (HLC).

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Scholarships at Chatfield



CCP Loyalty Scholarship:

- \$1,000 to any CCP students when enrolling at Chatfield the year after High School Graduation. Can be combined with other scholarships.

Merit Scholarships:



- 2.99 GPA or lower = \$1,000*
- 3.0- 3.69 GPA = \$2,000*
- 3.70 GPA or Higher = \$2,500*


*Per year for two years
