
# ACT and SAT Test Prep Materials

## Step 1:

### Create a Learning Express Hub Account

- Students, teachers, tutors must be in a CPS school or Hamilton County Library branch to create an account.
- We are part of the Hamilton Coop and this field will automatically populate when registering- do not change this field.
- Any type of email address can be used to create an account or choose “register without email”
